## Messaging 101

On October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2023, Hamas, an officially US-designated terrorist organization, invaded Israel and committed unspeakable atrocities. Not long after that, Rashida Tlaib was leading a protest against Israeli military operations in Gaza. Pulling off a stunt of this magnitude requires not only guts, but money, planning, logistical expertise and a well-honed understanding of how the US eusocial-cultural-messaging system works. So what if this was all set up and funded by the Socialist Haters of America or whatever. The operation was executed flawlessly and the message got sent out in dramatic fashion. Again, all this was set up in just a few days.

Call me an old fuddy-duddy, but isn't storming and occupying a US Federal Government office building illegal?
